Frequently Asked Questions:

What does it cost?

General Admission prices:

\$5.00 per person. Children under 2 are free. (Pumpkins are extra.)

Scheduled Group prices:

\$6.00 per student (includes pumpkin)

\$3.00 per chaperone (without pumpkin). Teachers & bus drivers are free.

How do I schedule a group? How do I get group rates? Please contact us by phone (270-269-2434 or by e-mail at ChristianWayFarm@aol.com). We will fit your group into the schedule during the week or on Saturdays. As best fits the needs of your group, we can book your tour for day or evening times. Can I come with just my family or a small group? Yes. During the week, please check with us to see when we have group tours scheduled. We will try to blend you with existing tours. If that simply does not work with your schedule, we will work with you and our family's schedule to try to arrange a time for you to still come. Remember that you can come any Saturday from 10-5 without making an appointment.

What will my group do? A scheduled tour includes story/teaching time. (For school teachers, you may access our website to find the KY core content subjects as we strive to teach curriculum appropriate). Each group will shell/crack corn and use it to feed our farm animals. A wagon ride behind the tractor will take your group to the corn maze and the pumpkin patch where you can pick a pumpkin or gourd of your choice. We will bring you & your pumpkins back to the barn, and will assist you in getting your pumpkins back to your vehicles. The remainder of your time is self-guided—lunch time, playtime, etc.

How long does a tour take? If you are a scheduled weekday tour, allow 1 ½ hours for the tour itself. You may plan for additional time to eat and play. Most groups are here for close to 3 hours. Many groups stay longer, depending on their schedule and the number of other groups we might have here.

Do you serve food? We sell snack items and drinks. During the cooler Saturdays in October, we often have ingredients for purchase to cook a hotdog or marshmallow over a fire. We sell food on Harvest Praise. Weekdays and other Saturdays we encourage you to bring your picnic lunch.

What kind of group can I bring? We welcome groups of all kinds and all ages. School groups, scout troops, church groups, company picnics, birthday parties, family reunions, FRG's. We adjust our tours to be age and subject appropriate. For an extra fee, we offer bonfires as requested by groups.

Where are you? How do I get to your farm? We are in the northeast corner of Christian County, just off of Highway 107, about 30 minutes north of Hopkinsville. Please go to our website to get detailed directions from your location.

Can I come during the week or on a Sunday? During the week, please call ahead. If you drive by and our gate is open, come to the barn and let us know you are here and we will get you started. We are closed on Sundays.

Do you have a gift shop? In addition to our fall produce, we have a Farm Gift Shop. We offer a variety of items from t-shirts, candles, games, toys, food items, and other products to purchase for gifts or reminders of your trip to a Kentucky farm. Items are priced with children and a family budget in mind.

What is Harvest Praise? On Saturday, October 17, we will have our 6th annual Harvest Praise. We have Christian music on our stage all day. We serve food—grilled selections and lots of extras. We have extra activities, including pumpkin painting, face painting, etc. Admission is \$6.00. See our website for more details.

Are you open during Fall Break? Since we serve so many counties, Fall Break is different for each county. Check with us or check our website for extra times we may be open during your fall break.
